# About BALI COMP

The Bali Underwater Hockey Invitational is an International Underwater Hockey Tournament held annually in Nusa Lembongan, Bali. Now in its 5<sup>th</sup> year, the event has welcomed over 250 participants from more than 10 countries, showing its growing international presence.

Set in the beautiful island of Nusa Lembongan, the event not only offers competitive gameplay but also highlights the natural beauty of Bali. This unique location creates a memorable experience for all participants.

The tournament runs over four days and includes two divisions: a main competitive category and a social division designed to encourage inclusive participation. Matches are held in half-day sessions, allowing players to balance competition and leisure. Outside of the games, participants can enjoy various island activities such as beach clubs, snorkeling, diving, island tours, and sunset sessions, creating a fun and social atmosphere throughout the event.

The Bali Underwater Hockey Invitational aims to grow the sport in the region while providing a high-quality, inclusive, and enjoyable experience for players of all levels.





# Game Formats

## Main Event – Mixed 6 v 6



- Form your own team
- Maximum of 12 players in the team
- Minimum of 2 female players in the water at all times
- Players must be at least 14 years old

## Social Event – Mixed 6 v 6



- Teams will be assigned by the organizer on a “potluck” basis
- Maximum of 12 players in the team
- Minimum of 2 female players in the water at all times
- Players must be at least 14 years old

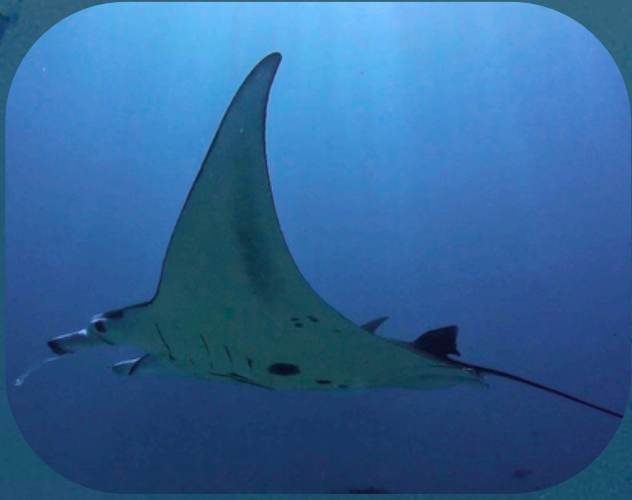

# FAQs

## Q How to get to Nusa Lembongan from Ngurah Rai International Airport?

You need to go to Sanur Port, then take a fast boat to Nusa Lembongan

## Q Which transportation is the best way to get to Sanur Port?

There are a few options:

- Airport Taxi – This is the easiest option from the airport, but it can be quite expensive, and you might need to bargain.
- Ride Apps (Grab or Gojek) – These are commonly used in Bali and Southeast Asia. They're cheaper, reliable, and more convenient. I highly recommend using one of these apps if you can.

## Q Which ferry is the best to get to Nusa Lembongan?

It depends on which harbor you prefer:

- To Jungutbatu Harbor: D'Camel, Arthamas, Glory
- To Mushroom Bay: The Tanis, Dream Beach Express

## Q How long is the ferry ride to Nusa Lembongan?

The ferry ride takes about 40 minutes

## Q What are the earliest and latest boats from Sanur Port & Nusa Lembongan?

- Earliest boat: 07:00 AM
- Latest boat: 05:00 PM

## Q How do we get to our accommodation from the harbor?

Most fast ferry companies offer free drop-off to your accommodation. Kindly ask at their counter when you check in before departure. If not, there are also local taxis available on the island

## Q How much is the taxi fare in Nusa Lembongan?

It's usually around IDR 100,000 to 150,000, depending on the distance and destination.

## Q How much is scooter rental in Nusa Lembongan?

- Small scooters: around IDR 80,000 – 100,000 per day
- Big scooters: around IDR 150,000 per day

## Q Where can I withdraw cash?

There are a few ATMs in Jungutbatu and Mushroom Bay, but not many. Sometimes they run out of cash or have technical issues. It's best to bring enough cash, but not too much. Most places also accept card payments

## Q Is there a standby medic during the event?

Yes, a standby medic team from Nusa Medica will be present throughout the event.

## Q Is there any post-event activity available?

Yes there is, for participants interested in post-event activities such as diving, snorkeling, and other island experiences, feel free to reach out to us. Prices are available upon request and advance booking is required.

## Q I don't have a team. Can I still register?

Yes, individual players are welcome to register. The organizer will assign you to a "Barbarian" team or place you in a team that requires additional players, subject to availability.
